

Job Opening – General Manager

The Weakley County Municipal Electric System (WCMES), is seeking candidates to replace the current General Manager who is retiring February 28, 2022.

WCMES employs approximately 65 employees, and serves over 20,000 electric customers in all of Weakley County and parts of Gibson and Obion counties. The service area encompasses approximately 650 square miles and includes seven cities and towns as well as a large rural area. Weakley County is also home to the University of Tennessee at Martin.

The General Manager is responsible for managing the daily operations of the System, hiring, training and retaining employees, compliance with all Federal, State and Local regulations, and implementing the policies of the eight-member Board of Public Utilities.

Minimum qualifications for the job include a minimum of a B.S. degree from an accredited institution, with a major in Engineering, Business, Management or a related field. The successful candidate will have a minimum of five years work experience at an electric utility, including supervisory and/or management duties, possess or be able to obtain a Tennessee Driver's License, and hold or agree to obtain within two years CPE certification through TVPPA. WCMES offers excellent benefits and will offer a competitive salary based upon qualifications and experience.
